Graduate Assistants are appointed in the summer of each year for the following Fall and Spring semesters. The stipend is \$6,000 for two semesters with an additional \$1500 for summer should that term be available. Along with the stipend, course fees up to a maximum of ten hours each semester will be waived. All other fees must be paid by the student. Graduate Assistants must be enrolled for at least six hours per semester and are permitted to enroll for only 10 hours during any one semester.

The graduate assistantship requires twenty hours of service per week to the College of Education and Professional Studies, during University business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Graduate assistants who wish to be employed in addition to their graduate assistantship assignments, must receive permission from the appropriate Graduate Director. Normally, permission will be granted if there is no conflict with academic or assistantship responsibilities.

## To be considered for an assistantship, a student must:

- 1. Be in "Regular Admission" status (requires minimum 3.00 gpa)
- 2. Submit three letters of recommendation
- 3. Submit application form

The doctoral assistantship requires twenty hours of service per week to the College of Education and Professional Studies, during University business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Doctoral assistants who wish to be employed in addition to their graduate assistantship assignments, must receive permission from the appropriate Graduate Director. Normally, permission will be granted if there is no conflict with academic or assistantship responsibilities.

- 1. Be currently enrolled in a doctoral program
- 2. Submit three letters of recommendation
- 3. Submit application form
